Transfers from Margaret River can be arranged.

Twin Share Bell tents with ensemble single beds, fitted sheet and pillow in pillow case. 2 and 3 bed options.

Camp kitchen: microwave, oven, fridge/ freezers, crockery, cutlery, cooking pots and utensils.

Tea room: tea, coffee, hot chocolate, snacks and fruit. Coffee machine and urn.

Ablutions with hot showers.

Helmets and boots if required.

Wet weather gear.

One of our beautiful horses and all your tack!

Your own comfortable riding gear or long trousers for riding.

Food and drinks for your dinner and breakfast.
